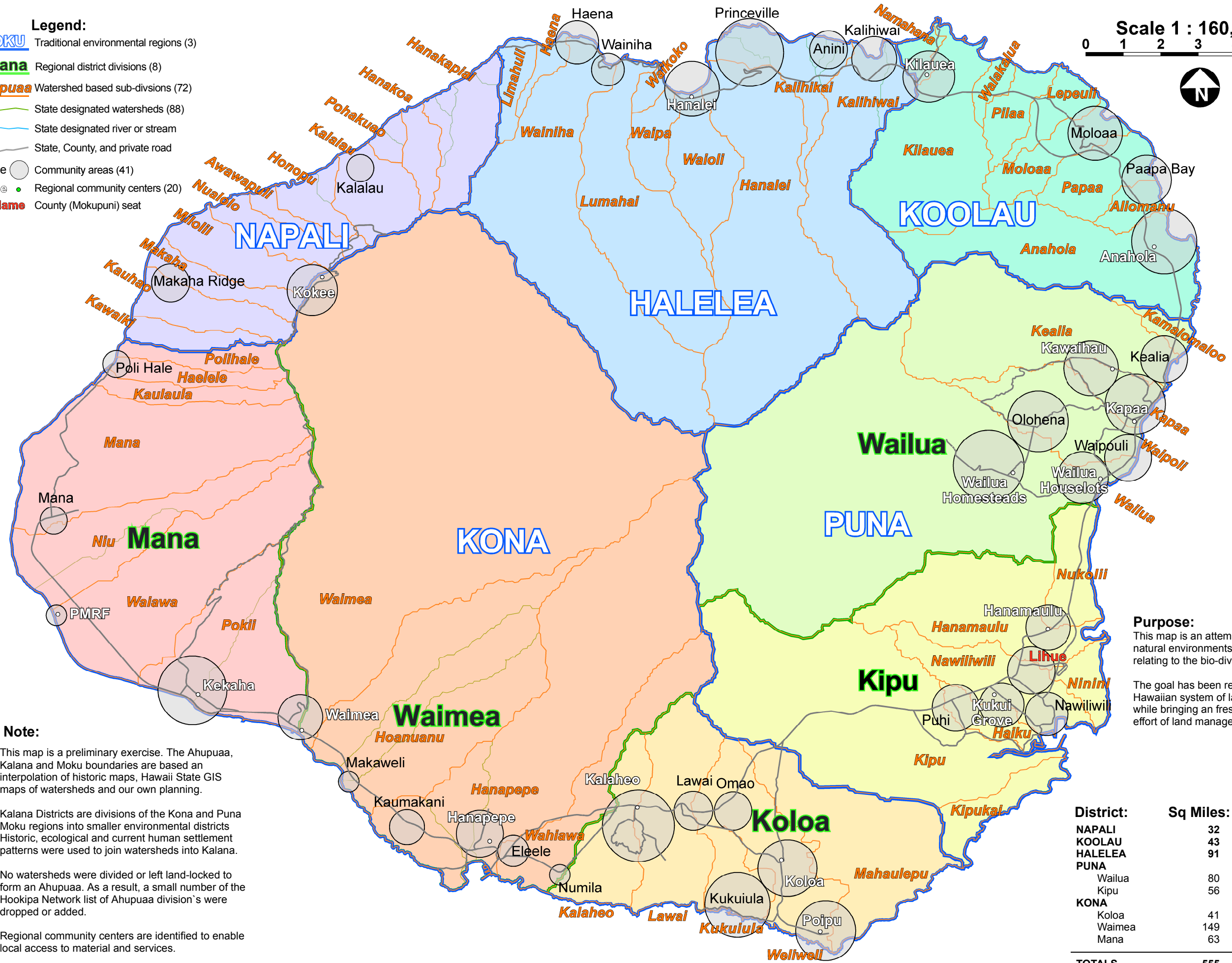
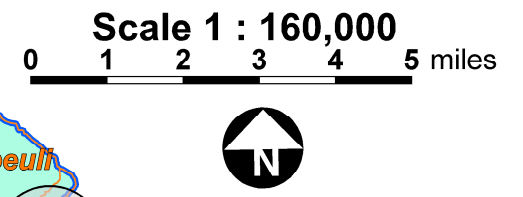

Note:
 This map is a preliminary exercise. The Ahupuaa, Kalana and Moku boundaries are based on an interpolation of historic maps, Hawaii State GIS maps of watersheds and our own planning.

Kalana Districts are divisions of the Kona and Puna Moku regions into smaller environmental districts. Historic, ecological and current human settlement patterns were used to join watersheds into Kalana.

No watersheds were divided or left land-locked to form an Ahupuaa. As a result, a small number of the Hookipa Network list of Ahupuaa division's were dropped or added.

Regional community centers are identified to enable local access to material and services.

 This map is an attempt to represent the natural environments of Kauai: A map relating to the bio-diversity of the island.

The goal has been respect the traditional Hawaiian system of land management while bringing a fresh perspective to the effort of land management.
